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INTRODUCTION

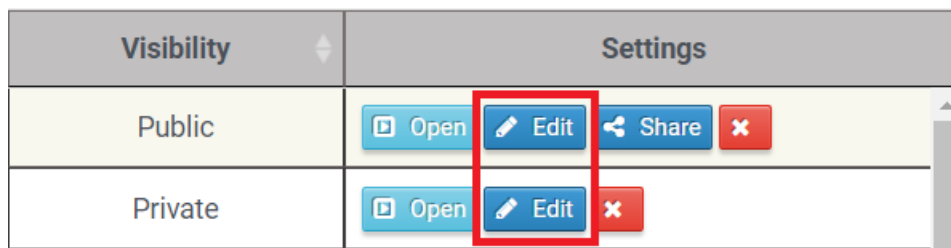
Share Playlist User Instructions

Playlist share allows sharing of playlists to both system and non-system users. For system users, playlists are visible on their account playlist page, and for non-system users, access to a shared playlist is provided using a link sent via mail. Playlist editing is not allowed for non-system users, only play and save the playlist is permitted. The email link to the playlist can only be used once by the non-system user.

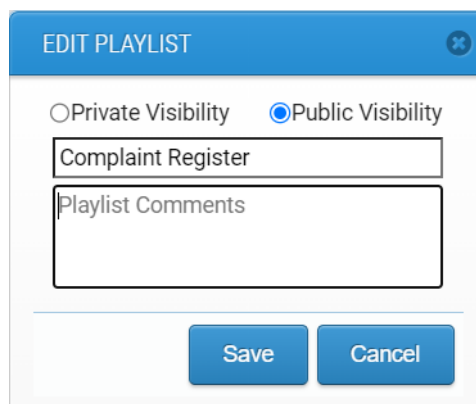
SHARE PLAYLIST

To Share a playlist, please follow the steps.

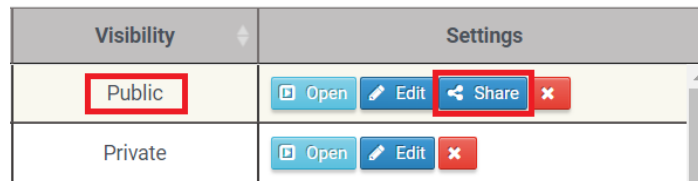
1. From the Playlist, Settings, click the Edit to change the Visibility



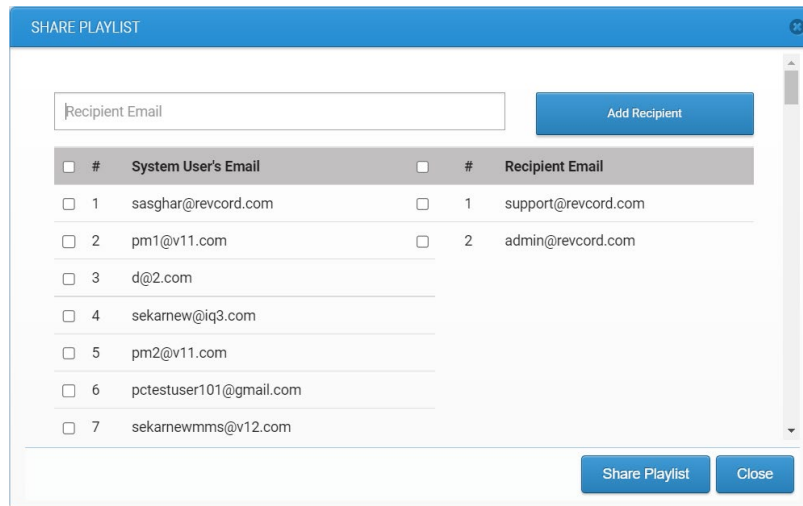
2. The playlist must be in public visibility mode. If not, please edit the playlist and check Public Visibility.



3. The Share button is now visible. Click on Share Button.

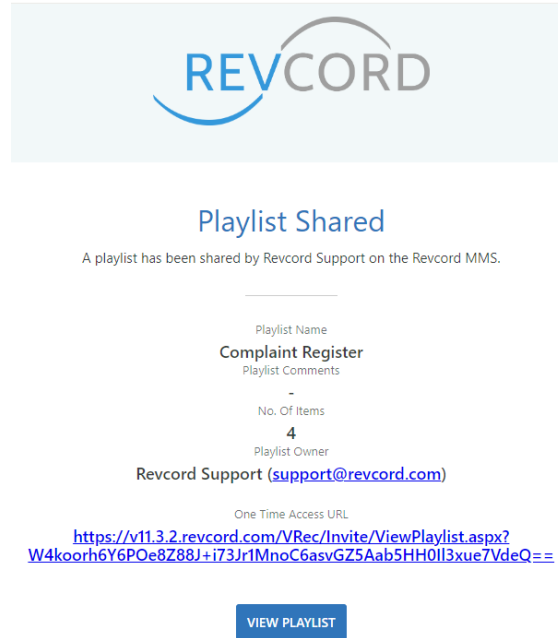


4. Select the users or add the non-system user email to share the playlist.

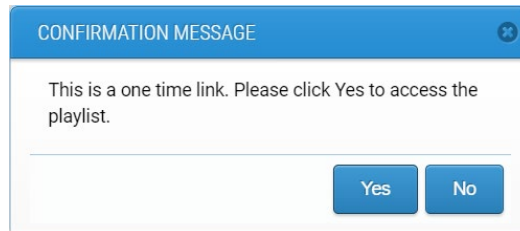


5. Click on Share Playlist.

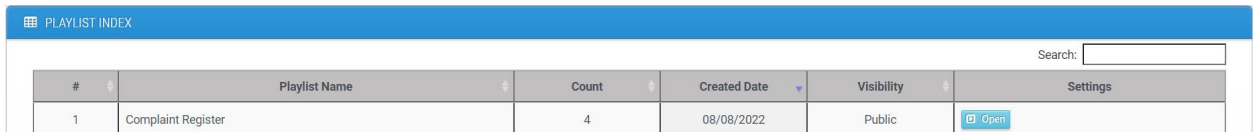
6. The email will be sent to non-system users.



7. Open the link received.






8. Click Yes to access the playlist one-time



9. The shared playlist must behave similarly except for the blocked edit functionality.

Points to Remember

1. Selecting an IQ3 event for evaluation is no longer done from the search page.
2. To be able to view an IQ3 playlist, it is required first to add the IQ3 event into a playlist.
3. An additional ability to add an event to the playlist has been implemented using an image button.

4. Clicking the IQ3 link, as shown in the above picture, will open up a dialog. All the existing playlists will be listed there. Users can select any playlist, and the selected event will be added to the playlist.

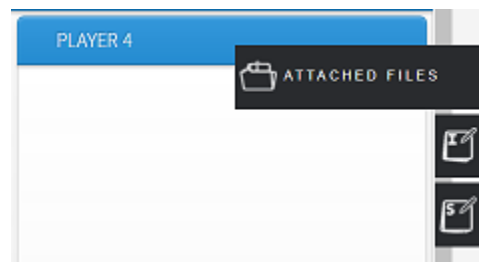

5. Once the event is added, you can view and save the report in pdf. Details are provided next.

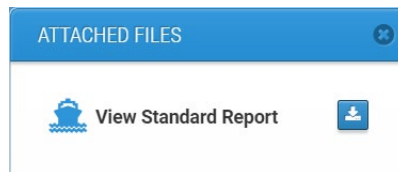
VIEW STANDARD / CUSTOM REPORTS AND EXPORT IN PDF FORMAT

In the playlist view during event playback, the user can view/see a standard/custom report. In addition, the ability to download the IQ3 report is also provided in the attached files dialog.

On the playlist, click the attached files link. Clicking the attached files will open up a dialog, and the playback pauses. As soon as the dialog closes, the playback will resume.



A dialog will open with the link to View Standard Report OR View the Custom Report.



To view the report, click on the View Standard Report as highlighted in the above picture.

In addition, the ability to download the pdf report has also been implemented. You can download the pdf report by clicking the download button new to View Standard Report.

If the user opts in Custom Reports for Vessel Id for an event, you can view/download the vessel report. If the user does not select vessel id during the event, the user can view/download the standard report in pdf format.
