

License Agreement for Revcard API SDK

By using the Revcard API SDK ("Software"), you ("Licensee") agree to be bound by the terms of this License Agreement ("Agreement"). If you do not agree to these terms, you are not authorized to use the Software.

1. Grant of License

- Revcard ("Licensor") grants Licensee a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the Software solely for integration with Licensee's own software, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

2. Prohibited Actions

- **Reverse Engineering:** Licensee shall not reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, use AI, or attempt to derive the source code, algorithms, or methodologies of the Software, including but not limited to AI-related features and functionalities.
- **Unauthorized Use:** Licensee shall not use the Software for any purpose other than those expressly permitted under this Agreement.

3. License Fee
